

ORDINANCE NO. 1

RE: PORTLAND GENERAL ELECTRIC COMPANY FRANCHISE

THE CITY OF MAYWOOD PARK DOES HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Said City does grant to Portland General Electric Company, an Oregon corporation, its successors and assigns, the non-exclusive right to erect, construct, maintain and operate within the corporate limits of said City, for a period of 10 years, an electric light and power system with all poles, wires, fixtures, underground circuits and equipment necessary or convenient and adequate to supply said City and its inhabitants with all reasonable electric energy for light, power and other purposes all as the inhabitants of said City may from time to time, reasonably require.

Section 2. The Franchise herein granted shall be all as contained in that certain written agreement executed this day by the Mayor of the City of Maywood Park, and accepted in writing by said Licensee by and through its President, a copy of which agreement is attached hereto and, by reference made a part hereof. The rights and duties of the City and said Portland General Electric Company are limited to those matters contained in said written agreement.

Section 3. The City of Maywood Park does hereby declare it necessary for the peace, health and safety of the people of said City that the arrangement herein by it and Portland General Electric Company be made immediately effective, and said City does thereby declare an emergency to exist. Accordingly, this Ordinance and the Franchise Agreement to which it refers shall be in full force and effect immediately upon the passage by all members of the Council of the City of Maywood Park and by written approval thereof by the Mayor of said City, provided, said Agreement be accepted in writing by an accredited official or officials of said Licensee within a period of five days of date hereof.
