

ORDINANCE NO. 18

An Ordinance regulating vehicle movement upon City streets and further providing for penalties.

BE IT ORDAINED that except as authorized by the terms of permits issued by the City Council, no person shall drive or move and no owner shall cause or permit to be driven or moved upon the streets of Maywood Park, any vehicle or combination of vehicles of a size or weight exceeding the following limitations:

- (1) Total outside width of eight feet, or
- (2) Total height of 10 feet, or
- (3) Total gross weight of 12,000 pounds, or
- (4) Having more than one rear axle.

Utility vehicles providing services to municipality residents shall be exempt from this Ordinance.

The operation of any vehicle or combination of vehicles in violation of this Ordinance shall be prima facie evidence that the owner of such vehicle or combination caused or permitted it to be so operated, and the owner shall be liable for any penalties imposed as a result of such operation.

A violation of this Ordinance shall result in a fine of not more than Five Hundred and no/100ths Dollars (\$500.00).

The City Council hereby declares an emergency, declaring that this Ordinance is immediately necessary to secure the continued general public health and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Maywood Park, and that this Ordinance is immediately necessary to conserve, stabilize, and protect property within the incorporated area of the City of Maywood Park. The Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
