

ORDINANCE NO. 21

**AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING VEHICULAR PARKING AT THE
CULDESAC AT THE WESTERLY END OF CAMPAIGN STREET.**

BE IT ORDAINED: that except as authorized by the terms of permits issued by the City Council, no vehicle shall park within the culdesac at the Westerly end of Campaign Street.

The parking of any vehicle in violation of this ordinance shall be prima facie evidence that the owner of such vehicle caused or permitted it to be so parked and the owner shall be liable for any penalties imposed as a result of said parking.

A violation of this ordinance shall result in a fine of not more than twenty dollars (\$20)

The City Council hereby declares an emergency, declaring that this Ordinance is immediately necessary to secure the continued general public health and general welfare of the citizens of the City of Maywood Park, and that this Ordinance is immediately necessary to conserve, stabilize, and protect property within the incorporated area of the City of Maywood Park. The Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
