

ORDINANCE NO. 16D

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 16, ATTACHMENT "A"
RELATING TO NUISANCE ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED that Ordinance No. 16D that shall go into effect immediately upon passage by the City Council of Maywood Park.

A. It shall be prohibited for any person to camp or sleep in or upon any public highway, street, alley, public park, parking lot, or other public place; or to camp or sleep in any barn, shed, shop, warehouse, automobile, vessel, or place other than such as is kept for lodging purposes, without the written permission of the owner or party entitled to possession thereof, and in no event for more than twenty four hours, except as provided for in Ord. 2006-3.

The City Council hereby declares an emergency, declaring that this Ordinance is immediately necessary to secure the continued general public health and general welfare of the citizens of Maywood Park, and that this Ordinance is immediately necessary to conserve, stabilize, and protect the property within the incorporated area of the City of Maywood Park. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.

Passed and approved by the City Council on the 17th day of July, 2012.


