SUBJECT: Required Resolution: State-Shared Revenue

The Intergovernmental Relations Division is responsible for certification of eligibility of cities for state-shared revenues (cigarette, liquor and highway taxes) under ORS 221.760.

The law provides that cities located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants, according to the most recent decennial census (1970), must provide four or more of the following municipal services to be eligible to receive the revenues:

- police protection,
- fire protection,
- street construction, maintenance and lighting
- sanitary sewers,
- storm sewers,
- planning, zoning & subdivision control,
- one or more utility services

In order to gain this certification, we will need to have a resolution from your Council which states that four or more of these services are being provided. A model resolution, applicable to your city under ORS 221.760 is enclosed for your City Council action.

We would appreciate your returning a copy of the Resolution to this office by October 15th, 1978.
