

ORDINANCE NO. 22C

ORIGINAL

An Ordinance amending Ordinance No. 22 relating to the criteria for issuing a Tree Removal Permit in the City of Maywood Park.

BE IT ORDAINED that Ordinance No. 22, Section 00:15, is amended to read:

00:15 CRITERIA FOR ISSUING A PERMIT

A Permit may be issued as requested in the Application, in whole or in part. It may also be denied in whole or in part, subject to compliance by the Applicant with reasonable conditions, including tree replacement, to be imposed in order to promote the purpose of this Ordinance.

- (9) The number of trees existing in a neighborhood, the character and property uses in the neighborhood, effect of tree removal and replacement upon neighborhood characteristics, beauty and property values;
- (11) The adequacy of the Applicant’s proposals and any plan to plant new trees and shrubs as substitutes for trees to be removed for improved landscaping or for complying with permit conditions.

BE IT ORDAINED that Ordinance No. 22, Section 00:21, is amended to read:

00:21 PENALTIES

Cutting or felling of trees in violation of this Ordinance, or breach of any terms of conditions of a permit granted under this Ordinance, or violation of any of the provisions, shall be unlawful, and the Applicant and/or Violator may be subject to a fine of not more than Three Thousand and no/100ths Dollars (\$3,000.00). The unlawful cutting of each individual tree shall be a separate offense hereunder.

Violator can be either or both: a homeowner who did not obtain a permit or a person or company who/which cut tree.


